

You are invited to a CoDA Recovery Hike!



WHEN: Saturday May 5, 2018 730 AM to 12 noon

WHERE: **Quarry Road Trail, Auburn**

HIKE DETAILS: 3.5 mile hike, with porta-pottys and picnic tables along the middle fork of the American river. See Hawyer cave, the limestone quarry, and rock climbers doing their thing. Choose the flat trail, or go steeper if you like, there's two ways to get to the end of the trail at the quarry.

DRIVING: To carpool or caravan, meet at Friends Church (41st and E, in East Sacramento) at **0730 AM**. It's a 40 mile drive. To drive on your own, meet at the trailhead parking lot at **0830**. We will start hiking promptly at 0845.

DIRECTIONS to trailhead parking lot: Hwy 80 east to exit 119C (Elm Avenue). Turn left on Elm Avenue. At the next light, turn left onto CA-49 S/El Dorado St/High Street and follow the signs for hwy 49. Go down the hill until you see the Auburn State Rec Area (straight) or bridge (right). Turn right and cross the bridge. The trailhead parking lot is about a half mile up hwy 49 on the left. Geo-coordinates: [38°54'44.2 N 121°02'08.6 W](#)

PARKING: Park for FREE on the right side of 49 between the bridge and the trailhead if there's a spot, or pay \$10 to park in the lot at the trailhead.
